Grooming

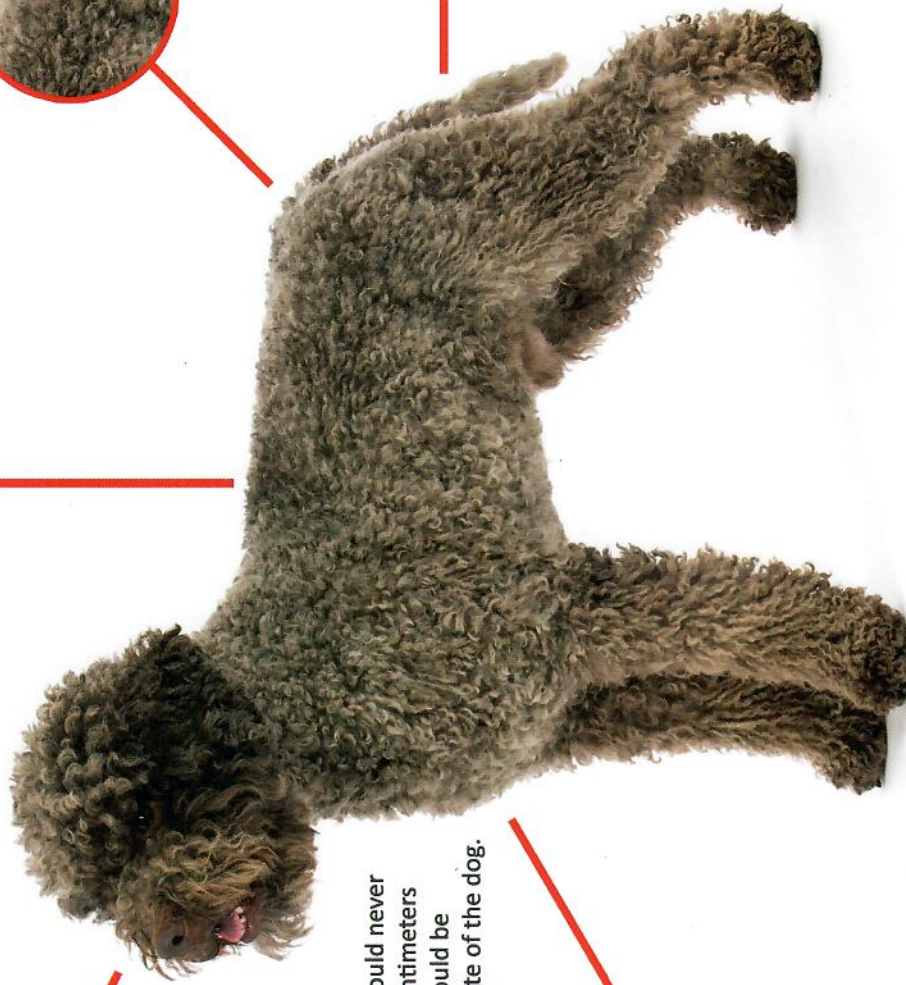
The back is straight, the shoulders slightly higher than the croup.

A thick curly coat with a woolly and slightly rough appearance on the outside.



The eyes visible without the impression of sunken eyes or that hard trim lines are visible.

The groomed coat should never be longer than 4 centimeters maximum and should be uniform with the silhouette of the dog.



The tail is carrot shaped.
This means the tailset is thicker than the tip of the tail.
The length of the coat is a little shorter on the bottom side of the tail than on the top side.

The coat must not be formed and brushed up in the fashion of the Poodles and Bichon frisé breeds. It should not be clipped short preventing it from curling or assessment of texture. The correct clip is un-pretentious and contributes to accentuate the natural, rustic look typical of the breed.
